As per information available as on 31.12.2013, a total number of 15028 Pak national are overstaying in India. State-wise list of overstaying Pakistani national is enclosed as annexure-I.

(b) to (c): Central Government is vested with powers to deport a foreign national, including a Pakistani national, illegally staying in the country under section 3(2) (c) of the Foreigners Act, 1946. These powers to identify and deport illegally staying foreign nationals have also been delegated to the State Governments/ UT Administrations. Detection and deportation of such illegal immigrants is a continuous process. Number of Pakistani Nationals deported during last three years is given below:-
