- (a) & (b) Government is aware of Pakistan's continued attempts to highlight the issue of Jammu and Kashmir in the United Nations.

Government continues to take all necessary measures to protect the sovereignty and territorial integrity of the nation. The entire State of Jammu and Kashmir is an integral part of the Indian Union. A part of the territory of the State is under the forcible and illegal occupation of Pakistan. Under the Simla Agreement, India and Pakistan are committed to resolving all outstanding issues, including the issue of Jammu and Kashmir, through a peaceful bilateral dialogue. There is no role whatsoever for a third party.
